FOURTH: The advancement of international understanding, goodwill and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.



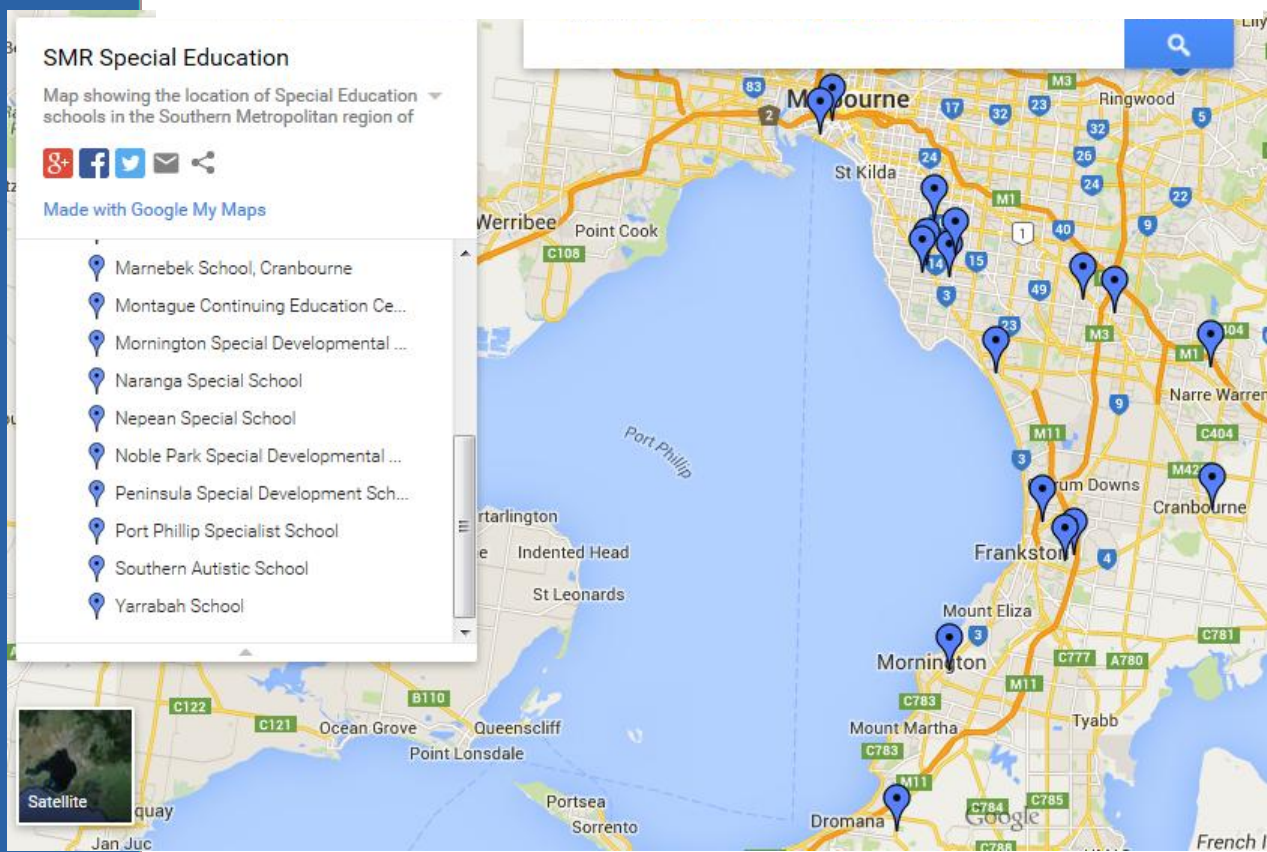
Inside the grounds of Yarrabah School

Yarrabah has grown quickly to meet an increasing need to educate and assist young people with special needs from the local area and from as far away as Dandenong and Frankston.

To become a special education teacher in Victoria you usually have to complete a degree in education, specialising in special education. To get into these courses you usually need to gain your VCE. Prerequisite subjects, or assumed knowledge, in one or more of English and mathematics are normally required. A number of universities in Australia offer degrees in education with a specialisation in special education. Universities have different prerequisites and some have flexible entry requirements or offer external study. Contact the universities you are interested in for more information as requirements may change.

Alternatively, you can undertake a Graduate Diploma of Education, specialising in special education, after completing a degree in teaching or other relevant areas such as arts, social work or disability studies. Entry to postgraduate courses usually requires completion of an appropriate bachelor degree as well as teaching experience or experience working with people with special needs. Contact the universities you are interested in for more information.

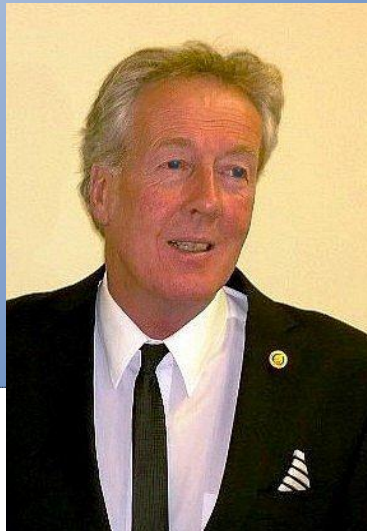
